



Instructions in respect of other river traffic

- 1. A warning notice regarding the event has been placed at local locks**
- 2. All conversations with other river users shall be polite, informative and concise. Actions required of other river traffic shall be requested with the safety element emphasised.**
- 3. All river traffic movement in sight of a course official shall be immediately reported to the Coordinating Umpire who will communicate the presence of other boats on the water. All umpires & marshals must advise on the progress of traffic whilst it is in their area of jurisdiction.**
- 4. Any river user approaching the course should be advised of the Presence of competing boats on the water and requested to take extra care pending confirmation from the Coordinating Umpire that it is safe to proceed.**
- 5. Safety of competitors, officials and other river traffic users is paramount. All event officials are empowered to suspend racing in the event of imminent danger to any of the above.**

ALL RADIO MESSAGES ON ANY SUBJECT MUST BE KEPT SHORT AND TO THE POINT AND SHOULD BE REGARDING THE SAFE AND EFFICIENT RUNNING OF THE EVENT
